

Impact of 2019 / 2020 Sport Premium Funding Spend

- This year we have sought to maintain our growing involvement in sports and physical activity outside of the curriculum, (despite the year being cut short due to the Coronavirus pandemic), through active playtimes, continuation of the Daily Mile, active lessons, after school clubs, daily wake-up shake up activities and in taking part in more festivals and competitions through the South Tyneside School Sports Network.
- **100% of pupils participated in a School Games sports festival** again this year, (Reception, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6). which is pleasing due to events only being ran up until March due to Coronavirus.
- Again, Year 5 and 6 entered league and cup competitions for which they received extra lunch-time coaching.
- Our football team took part successfully in league and cup matches again up until March **increasing pupil participation in competitive school sport** and showing the impact of their extra coaching sessions. Unfortunately, competitions and league were not finished due also to the coronavirus pandemic.
- Equipment was also purchased, including new goal posts and playground resources in order for us to train and host cup games to **increasing pupil participation in competitive school sport** and **increase participation in sport and physical activity during playtimes and lunchtimes.**
- Year 6 were trained as Young Leaders through the Playmaker Award coaching, to **increase participation in sport and physical activity during playtimes and lunchtimes.**
- Some classes also enjoyed **some specialist coaching** through a skipping day, which cost £250.
- Gymnastics and Multi-Skills after-school clubs were ran to encourage participation of the younger children (Reception and Year One) in school to take up a new sport, something they voted for through our online survey.

The total spend from Sport Premium for this year was: **£5666.20**
