

# St Joseph's Catholic Primary School, Jarrow Key stage 2 Provisional Results School, BCCET and national comparisons September 2022



These are the first key stage 2 attainment statistics since 2019, after assessments were cancelled in 2020 and 2021 due to the pandemic. These statistics cover the attainment of our year 6 pupils (cohort of 30) who took assessments in summer 2022.

These pupils experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic, particularly at the end of year 4 and in year 5.

## St Joseph's pupils achieved higher than the national average in <u>all</u> subjects.

## St Joseph's KS2 headline results July 2022

## Reading, Writing and Maths combined

**St Joseph's:** 83% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022, **up** from 66% in 2019 **National:** 59% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022, down from 65% in 2019 **BCCET:** 64% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022, down from 71% in 2019

# **Reading**

**St Joseph's:** 90% of pupils reached the expected standards in 2022, **up** from 69% in 2019 **National:** 74% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022, up from 73% in 2019 **BCCET:** 81% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022, up from 81% in 2019

#### Writing

**St Joseph's (Teacher Assessment):** 87% of pupils reached the expected standards in 2022, **up** from 83% in 2019

**National: (Teacher assessment)** 69% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022, down from 78% in 2019

**BCCET: (Teacher assessment)** 80% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022, down from 84% in 2019

#### **Maths**

**St Joseph's:** 93% of pupils reached the expected standard, **up** from 83% in 2019 **National:** 71% of pupils reached the expected standard, down from 79% in 2019 **BCCET:** 80% of pupils reached the expected standard, down from 85% in 2019

## **Grammar, punctuation and spelling**

**St Joseph's:** 77% of pupils reached the expected standard, **up** from 72% in 2019 **National:** 72% of pupils reached the expected standard, down from 78% in 2019

BCCET: 80% of pupils reached the expected standard

#### **Science**

**St Joseph's: (Teacher Assessment)** 87% of pupils reached the expected standard, **up** from 83% in 2019

**National: (Teacher Assessment)** 79% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022, down from 83% in 2019

BCCET: (Teacher assessment) 87% of pupils reached the expected standard in 2022

Attainment in science is not directly comparable to some earlier years (2016, 2017 and 2018) because of changes to science teacher assessment frameworks in 2019.
