#### Cool Milk Scheme

Our school will be providing a new milk scheme **after Easter** that is available to all of our pupils. School milk is free for under-5s, and for over-5s it is available at a subsidised price of 28p per day. Further details will follow with instructions of how to register. Each child that registers with Cool Milk will receive a 189ml portion of semi-skimmed milk every day, delivered fresh and chilled to the classroom. Their school milk will not only provide them with essential nutrients, but as it is rehydrating and energy boosting it also bridges the gap between breakfast and lunch to help children stay focused.
