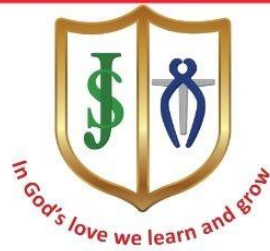

Being creative and learning to express themselves











Content
