First Holy Communion

Attendance and Term Holidays

We have had a number of queries from parents regarding school holidays, and how our term dates don't match with the local authorities. The decision to align the school holidays for Catholic schools across the region was raised by the diocese education department and agreed with the catholic trusts in the region. The intention was to provide consistency of school holidays across all the catholic schools for our pupils, parents, and staff, as the schools work across a large number of local authority areas with varying term dates. Unfortunately, this means that some of the dates for the 2023/24 school holidays aren't aligned with local authority term dates. Given that this information has already been published, it is not possible for the trust to amend the dates at this stage without disrupting parents and staff who have already made arrangements. The trust has stated that they will work with the Diocese and other Trusts to ensure future holidays are aligned as closely as possible to local authority holidays. Apologies for the problems this has caused many of our families.
