The National Curriculum is formed of core subjects and foundation subjects. The core subjects are English, Mathematics and Science. As a Catholic school, the teaching of Religious Education (RE) is also core to our curriculum.

The foundation subjects are: Art and Design, Computing, Design and Technology, Geography, History, Music and Physical Education. We also teach Languages (French) in Key Stage 2, with younger pupils learning the basics of the language.

In addition, Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE), including Relationship and Sex Education (RSE) is required to be taught.

Science	We will be learning about Animals Including Humans, we will explore the life stages of humans from birth to old age and the changes that our bodies undergo. This includes the changes the body undergoes during puberty.
	We will also be learning about Earth and Space. We will be investigating how the Earth and Moon move around the sun and the impact that has on our lives.
Key vocabulary	Humans, life stages, gestation, toddler, adolescence, puberty, old age. Solar System, Orbit, planets, axis, rotate, moon, day, night, Geocentric and Heliocentric theories.

History	We will be learning about Anglo Saxons and the Vikings. We will explore the impact the invasions had on our country in terms of social life, religion and the economy.

Geography	We will be learning about Settlements and land use. We will explore the features of settlements and understand why land use has changed over time.

RE	We will be learning about: Ourselves and the Domestic Church Life choices - including baptism and marriage Judaism Hope - Advent/ Christmas

Art	We will be learning about Self Portraits and the use of continuous lines. We will explore the use of proportion to draw facial features and look at the work of artist Boris Schmitz to recreate our own self portrait in the style of him.
Key vocabulary	Portraits, proportion, abstract, continuous line, facial features, complementary colours, Boris Schmitz

Design & Technology	We will be learning about Cooking and Nutrition. We will learn how to make Pretzels, from sampling different types of bread, to creating ingredients lists and recipes, to designing our own, to actually making and tasting!
Key vocabulary	Pretzel, bread, health and safety, ingredients, recipes, sensory, tasting, texture, evaluated, healthy menu, measure

PSHE	We will be learning about Religious Understanding, Emotional well-being and life cycles. We will learn about the choices we each make and the impact those choices can have on other people.

Computing	We will be learning about Systems and Networks. We will develop our understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices. We will learn how information is found on the World Wide Web, through learning how search engines work (including how they select and rank results) and what influences searching, and through comparing different search engines.
