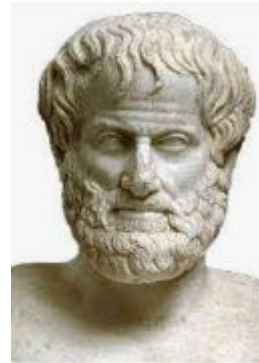

What is the STJ?

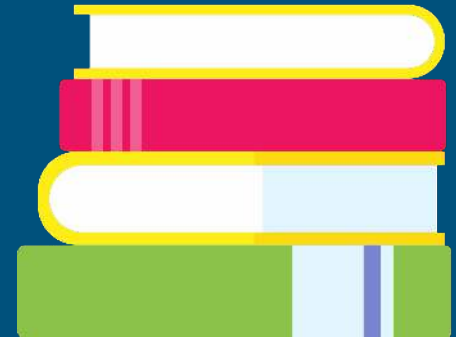
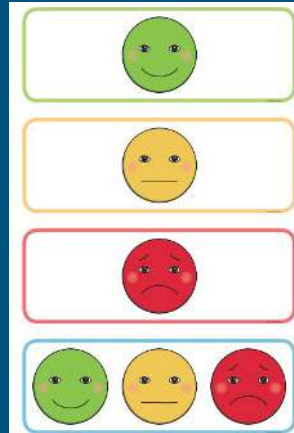


- The STJ is a standard.
