Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well.

I wanted to take a moment to remind everyone about our school's policy regarding earrings. At our school, we have a policy in place that states that pupils are not allowed to wear earrings, including spacers, unless their ears have been recently pierced. If children are not allowed to remove ear studs (their ears may just have been pierced) then parents should cover the studs with sticking plasters whilst the children are in school. We kindly request that any ear piercing be done during the 6-week summer holidays to allow sufficient healing time. In line with this policy, our staff will ask pupils to remove any earrings during school hours. In cases where earrings cannot be removed by the pupils themselves, we may kindly ask parents to come in and assist with their removal.

This policy is in place to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all our pupils. By adhering to it, we can prevent any potential accidents or injuries that earrings may pose during physical activities or playtime.
