School shoes and PE kits

We are noticing an increasing number of pupils wearing shoes, trainers or boots that are not in line with our school uniform policy <u>link</u> A reminder that our policy states that pupils must wear *'Black sensible shoes (plain black trainers without stripes are allowed)'*

Also, more and more pupils are wearing a range of clothing for PE. Again, a reminder that our policy states that the PE kit is **black plimsolls, red t-shirt and blue shorts**. We do allow dark, <u>unbranded</u> leggings or joggers at the moment as the weather is cold. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate PE kit on their allocated days – plimsolls can be kept in their school bag if needed, or a PE kit can be kept in school. Unfortunately, pupils will not actively take part in PE lessons if they do not have the correct PE kit, and we will contact parents to ask that they ensure their child has the appropriate clothing. Consistency in school uniform is important for a number of reasons including fostering a sense of community and reduced distractions relating to clothing choice.
